EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN AND GIRLS AN INDICATOR DERIVED FROM HOUSEHOLD SURVEYS

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Rationale & methods

- 1. Identified a set of DHS 'gender variables'
- 2. Chose those more directly related to EWG to include in the index
- 3. Age 1st birth required data imputation
- 4. After further discussion and analysis, some variables were removed
 - Restricted to a small number of women (decision CP use, type of earnings)
 - Not related to woman, but HH (phone)
 - Not asked in all surveys (decision CP)
 - Some we decide to exclude after we performed some tests with and without them in the index



Rationale & methods

- With these variables, we used PCA to check in each country which variables would charge higher – results highly consistent
- So, we performed the same analysis gathering data from all countries together.
